The Regional Landcare Coordinator will be employed for 21 hours per week up to 30 June 2023. The position will be hosted by Central West Lachlan Landcare and can be based across the Central West region of NSW.

The Regional Landcare Coordinator will work with the Local Landcare Coordinators and the Central West Natural Resource Management Working Group (Community of Practice) to deliver outcomes of the NSW Landcare Program.

Key Deliverables of the Central West Regional Landcare Coordinator are:

- Delivery of Regional Projects
- Reporting on Regional Projects to funding bodies, RLC Steering Committee and Central West Lachlan Landcare Committee
- Ability to work with partners to support, facilitate, and build new or existing regional Community-of-Practice networks
- Increase participation in the regional Community-of- Practice from Landcare, Local Land Services and other organisations and agencies – Central West Natural Resource Management Working Group.
- Increase capacity of Local Landcare Coordinators to deliver on the program outcomes
- Monitor, evaluate and report on program outcomes at a regional scale
- Facilitate linkages between Landcare activities/projects and Local Land Services and Landcare NSW strategic objectives
- Identify and facilitate potential regional joint initiatives, funding opportunities and collaborative programs
- Work towards improved financial stability and long-term viability of regional initiatives and programs
- Develop and implement a Regional Priority Plan and support its implementation
- Participation in and contribution to State Landcare Community-of-Practice
